She has been involved in indigenous cultural and intellectual property and environmental issues for over 30 years at tribal, national, Pacific regional and international levels, writing prolifically on these topics and serving on the Council of the International Union for Conservation of Nature. She led the organisation of the conference that developed the 1993 Mataatua Declaration, as well as numerous other national, regional and international conferences on traditional knowledge, cultural and intellectual property rights, biodiversity and genetic resources.
