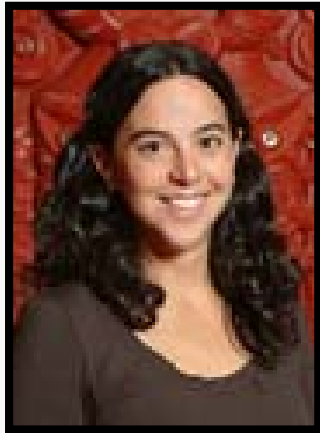

“Sustainable self-determination: Oil or Soil?”

Dr Maria Bargh of Ngāti Kea/Ngāti Tuara of Te Arawa and Ngāti Awa has a PhD in Politics and International Relations from the Australian National University. She is editor of *Resistance: An Indigenous Response to Neoliberalism* (2007); and *Māori and Parliament* (2010). Her current research on Indigenous Peoples involved in renewable and non-renewable energy is funded by a Marsden Fast Start. Her research interests include Indigenous and Pacific politics, diverse local political economics, neoliberalism and Renewable energy. Maria is currently a lecturer in Māori Studies at Victoria University of Wellington.
